

Mansfield Teen Autism Family Support Hub Session dates for 2025

The aim of the teen hub is to offer support and a safe space for families who have teenagers on the Autistic Spectrum. Teenagers (including siblings) can participate at their own pace with support from parents and our staff team if needed. We offer a choice of activities including themed arts and crafts, table top games, sports activities, sensory room and garden. There is also a communal area so you can sit back and enjoy some refreshments, whilst talking to other families and sharing experiences or speaking with staff for advice and support.

There is a charge of £1 for refreshments, and we would also be really grateful if you could donate what you can afford towards the running of the session. Cash is preferred.

Directions – the postcode NG19 9BG takes you to an industrial estate, not specifically to the Sherwood Centre.

From Old Mill Lane (A6117), turn into Hallam Way at a mini roundabout with Greggs on the corner. Follow Hallam way straight up the hill until you come to a t-junction – Hallam Way continues to the right. Drive up here, past the Royal Mail on the left – the entrance to the Sherwood Centre is next on the left after Royal Mail.
