How to find the Birstall Methodist Centre;

As you go up Wanlip Lane, away from the roundabout that is the junction for Sibson Road and Birstall Road, the Church and Centre are on your left, opposite the school. If you're coming by car, there are some parking spaces off road in front of the Centre, and some more round the corner on The Crossways. There is also further residential on street parking. Use the door in the 'middle' of the building at the back of the off road car parking spaces facing onto Wanlip Lane.
